

Occupational Noise Policy

The objective of this policy is to achieve compliance with the Worksafe Australia standard for occupational noise. The national standard for exposure to noise in the workplace is an average daily level of 85 decibels. For peak noise incidents the National Standard is 140 decibels. (Peak linear level)
These levels are defined as the maximum acceptable levels for noise.

Steadfast roofing has responsibilities to work in accordance with the standard to ensure that:

- Statutory requirements are complied with
- A noise control policy and programme of action are developed
- Management and employees are aware of the control measures to reduce exposure to noise
- All employees are encouraged to cooperate in using agreed safety work practises
- Information on noise, the risk of exposure to noise and the appropriate control measures are designated in a manner appropriate to the workplace
- A comprehensive personal hearing protection programme including the selection of personal hearing protectors is implemented and employees receive appropriate training and education when it is required
