

No Working Live Policy

Steadfast Roofing has a 'no working live policy'. It is a requirement that all electrical work is carried out qualified electrician using the safe system of work. The safe system of work must include:

Follow Isolation Procedures

Isolation and tagging procedures cover basic safety principles to protect employees and equipment when conducting repair work. The circuits and apparatus of that part of the installation being worked on must not be energised.

It is a requirement that before any repairs or alterations are commenced the electrical circuit is isolated tagged and locked.

Tags must be destroyed after use and not reuse.

Before you start work:

- **Identify power source**
- **Isolate circuits and switches**
- **Test the circuit is completely isolated**
- **Tag using correct tag**
- **Lock where possible or switches and circuits**

Isolate Where Practical and Shield Exposed Conductors

Eliminate or control the likelihood of the person carrying out the work inadvertently contacting any part of the installation that remains energised. Any exposed conductor in the work area should be confirmed by the worker as isolated and or securely shielded from possible contact.

Test Every Time Before You Touch

Check to ensure that the circuit and apparatus of the part of the installation that is being worked on are not energised before work commences and remain that way until the work is completed.



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
